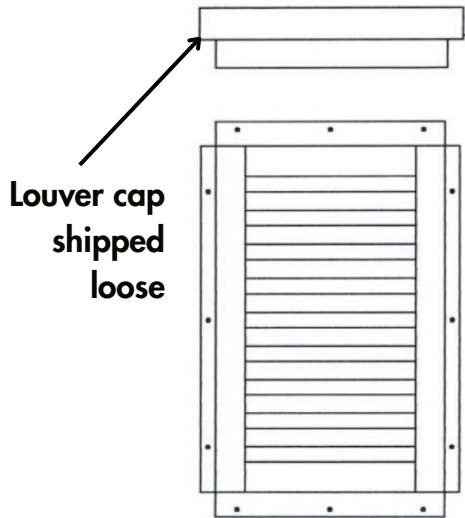
A framed opening, as in a wall, door, or window, fitted with fixed or movable horizontal slats for admitting air or light and often for shedding rain.

All 29 ga prepainted steel construction with bird screen.

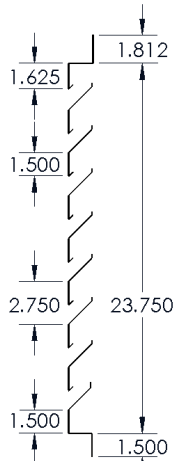
Approximately 1.5" nailing flange on all four sides.

Color Matching to over 100 colors.

All metal edges are hemmed for strength & easier handling.

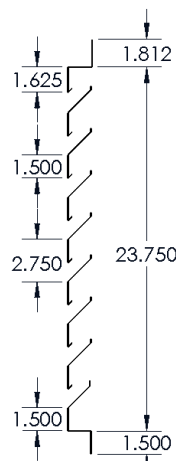

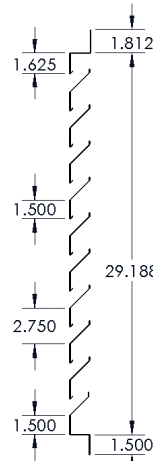

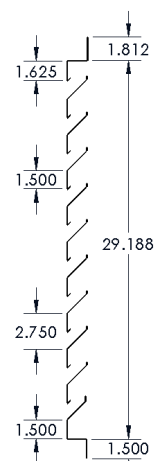
